Over the last 12 months. World ParaVolley has conducted the following activities:

TESTING

- Eight (8) in-competition tests (4M, 4F). The distribution of athletes tested covered athletes from Americas, Asia and Europe.
- One (1) targeted out-of-competition test was conducted from the Registered Testing Pool list
- One (1) tip off received and followed up

From the World ParaVolley sanctioned tests above, no anti-doping rule violations were found.

Work is underway to review of our testing strategy and distribution.

- Education material was available during international competition
- World ParaVolley is currently reviewing its education plan in order to better serve the athletes and support personnel
