### NOTICE FROM THE TECHNICAL DIRECTOR

#### Official Match Protocol

- We remind all teams that they MUST be in the competition hall 30 minutes before their official match time.
- If the previous match in the agenda is not completed 30 min before the official match time, the Jury will request the referees to respect the official protocol timeline.

#### **Changing Rooms**

- · Before their match, teams have access to a changing room outside the competition hall.
- Before they enter the competition court, they are requested to leave all their unnecessary equipments for the match in a basket left at their disposal in the changing room.
- A volunteer from the Local Organizing Committee will collect the basket and will move it to the changing room located inside the competition venue.
- After their match, teams will collect their equipments in the new changing room.

### **Mongolia Country Code**

- Mongolia's country code will be changed for MGL instead of MON.
- · This code will apply to all official documents.

#### **Democratic Republic of Congo**

- At this point, we cannot ensure the Team will be able to attend the competition.
- Due to this uncertainty, we took the tough decision to withdraw the team from the competition. World ParaVolley aims at increasing participation, fulfilling teams and players' expectations while protecting its regulations and fair-play. According to the information we have and considering all aspects, this was the best option we had.
- Should the Team arrive, we will provide them with opportunities to play friendly games with some of you who are interested. However, this will not affect the competition.

#### **Competition Schedule Change**

- With DR Congo out of the competition, we are amending the competition schedule accordingly. Please refer to the updated schedule in this Bulletin.
- To provide all teams with the opportunity to visit Jeju Island, Friday, March 30th will be a day off. Nevertheless, it's up to the teams to book a training session if required.
