Qi AN was born in October 1963. She is Master of Sports Event management from University of Technology Sydney. Bachelor of Sports Training Specialty from Beijing Sport University. She works in the Capital Institute of Physical Education as an Assistant Professor, and a master's supervisor. She has been engaged in volleyball teaching, training, scientific research, competition organization and referee work since 1985.

She was the first to contact with sitting volleyball in 1994. She was awarded the national referee in 2003. She has participated in the international and domestic referee work of sitting volleyball for many times. As an international Referee, Qi has participated in the Paralympic Games twice and participated in intercontinental international competitions for many times; Since 2010, she has served as the TD of domestic sitting volleyball tournament, with rich experience in competition arrangement, competition organization and on sitting volleyball referee.
