



## **World ParaVolley Anti-Doping Commission Annual Report 2017**

### **Anti-Doping Testing Statistics 2017**

In 2017, World ParaVolley conducted the following activities:

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#### **TESTING**

- Forty-seven (47) in-competition tests (M = 25; F = 22) The distribution of athletes tested covered athletes from Americas, Asia, Africa and Europe, and were chosen on the basis of the World ParaVolley Risk Assessment.
  - Three (3) targeted out-of-competition tests were conducted from the Registered Testing Pool list. Nine (9) other tests were conducted out-of-competition. Males tested = 4; Females tested = 9
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#### **ANTIDOPING RULE VIOLATIONS with SANCTIONS**

- 1 ADRV (sanction pending hearing prior to publishing)
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#### **TUE's**

- 4 TUE's were reviewed by the TUEC.
  - Of these, 3 were accepted and 1 was rejected
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#### **EDUCATION**

- Questionnaires to athletes regarding anti-doping awareness were circulated at international competitions
- World ParaVolley completed a two-year education plan in order to better serve the athletes and support personnel.
- World ParaVolley contracted Chinada to given an Anti-Doping presentation to athletes at the World Super Six Competition.
- Also contracted the Egyptian NADO who presented Anti-Doping lecture to athletes at the African Zonal Championships.

In 2017, we recruited a legal advisor to assist us with anti-doping matters. We have also recruited a volunteer education manager, Isadora Toscano, to the Commission.
