# Dusan Dovicovic

## *Deceased*

Dusan passed away on 26th February 2017

Dusan Dovicovic started his refereeing career in 1975 and quickly made it to the highest division of the former Czechoslovakia's national league where he refereed his first matches in 1982. He completed his International Referee Candidature Course in 1990 in Poland and eventually became an international referee one year later and qualified as an ISOD (International Sports Federation of the Disabled) Referee in 1992. He was involved in standing volleyball attending the World Championships held in Cambodia as well as the 1996 Paralympic Games in Atlanta. Many players, coaches and sports officials in Slovakia, and abroad as well, acknowledged and respected his personality, skills and professional demeanour. Dovicovic was a member of the Refereeing Commission at the Slovak Volleyball Federation and also acted as Chairman of the Advisory Board of the Slovak Association of Volleyball Referees.

Dusan was involved as a referee at the following events:

- 1999 – World Cup – Laval, Canada
- 2001 – World Cup – Púchov, Slovakia
